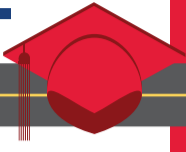

99% OF THE STUDENTS WE SERVE **REMAIN** IN SCHOOL

86% OF STUDENTS **REACHED** THEIR BEHAVIORAL GOALS

96% OF CIS SENIORS **GRADUATED**
